

Sacred Alchemy, a Debut Album by Devaa Haley, Awakens the Full Power and Expression of the Sacred Feminine

With 13 passionate songs, this album offers listeners a world-centric spirituality by evoking and celebrating the feminine face of the divine from diverse traditions such as the Hindu goddesses Narayani and Kali, the Hawaiian goddess Pele, the Christian Mary Magdalene and Hopi's Spider Woman.

"My goal with this album was to express 13 very different faces of the goddess so that people can experience and relate to the diversity of feminine power and expression.
